


How to update your EVE Exploration Google spreadsheet to the latest version




1. This document shows how to update your EVE Exploration Google spreadsheet to the latest version. If you don't already have your own EVE Exploration Google spreadsheet yet, refer to **How to get your own EVE Exploration Google spreadsheet awesomeness.pdf** instead.
2. Go to Google Drive (<https://drive.google.com/>) in a web browser.
3. Open your EVE Exploration Google spreadsheet.
4. Choose **View** → **Hidden sheets (2)** → **Systems** in the menu to unhide the Systems sheet:



5. Choose **File** → **Import...** in the menu:



6. In the **Import file** window that pops up, select **Replace current sheet** and click on the **Choose File** button:



7. Select the file **Systems.csv** somewhere on your hard drive, USB drive or whatever storage the file is on, open it and click on the **Import** button:






8. Choose **Tools** → **Script editor...** in the menu:



9. Open the file **EVE Exploration – Code.gs** somewhere on your hard drive, USB drive or whatever storage the file is on, in a text viewer or text editor, select all the text, copy it to the clipboard, go back to the browser window, select all the text in the Script editor, paste the text from the clipboard and choose **File** → **Save** in the menu:



10. Close the tab with the Script editor open in it (should be the current tab), go to the tab with the Google spreadsheet open in it (should now be the current tab after closing the Script Editor tab) and choose **Spreadsheet** → **(Re-)initialize** in the menu:



11. That should do the trick! Enjoy!
